Complete Guide to Using the Secure Track ELD System

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ELD Device Setup

Step 1

Ensure that your vehicle's engine is turned OFF. If it is currently running, please switch it off and turn the ignition key to the 'Off' position before connecting the ELD device.

Step 2

Find the diagnostic port inside your vehicle. It's usually located in one of these places: under the left side of the dashboard, below the steering wheel, near the driver's seat, or under the driver's seat



Step 3

To connect the ELD, plug it into your vehicle's diagnostic port. Twist the locking ring until it clicks into place. Make sure the ELD is securely connected.

Step 4

Once plugged in, the device will begin syncing with the engine control module (ECM) and the Secure Track ELD app on your tablet.


Step 5

Next, turn on the tablet provided by your fleet and open the Secure Track ELD Application.




Login

- Enter your registered email address in the **Username** field.
- Fill in your **password**.

- To save your login details for future use, enable the Remember Password option.






- Tap the red Connect signal button located in the top-right corner.



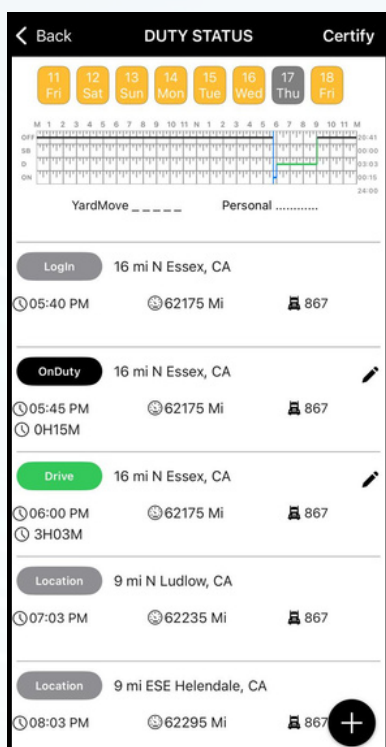

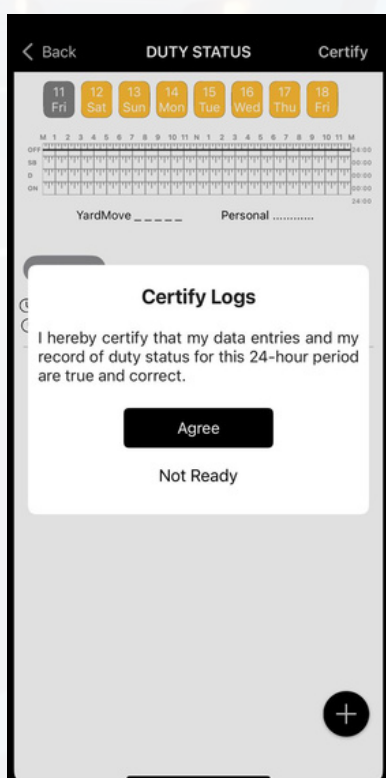
- The system will change the status to 'Driving' and display complete information.

Logs Dashboard



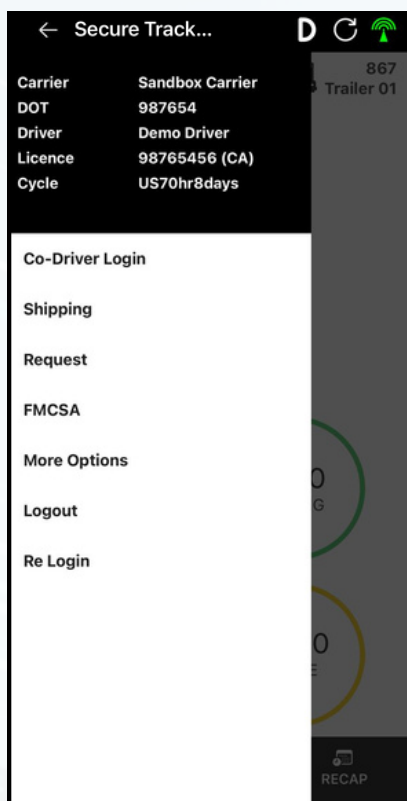
- Open Logs from the bottom menu.

Certification



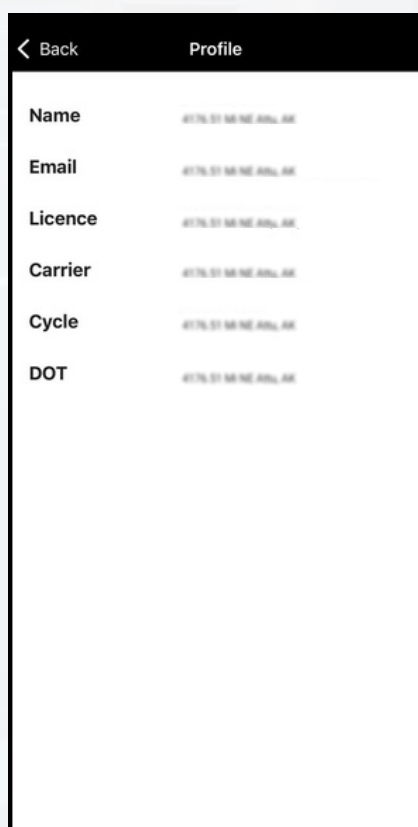
- Click on the certify button on the top right corner.

App Menu



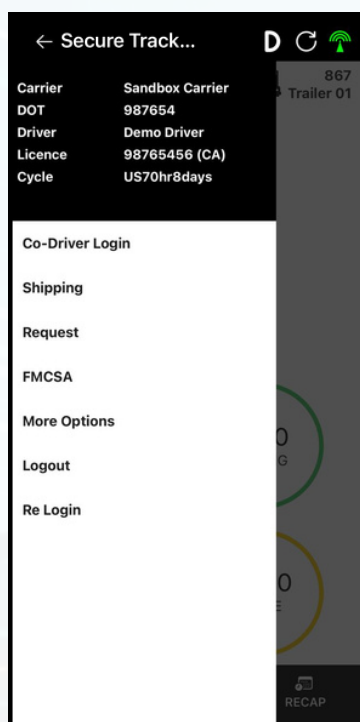
- Click on the hamburger icon on the left corner.

Driver Profile

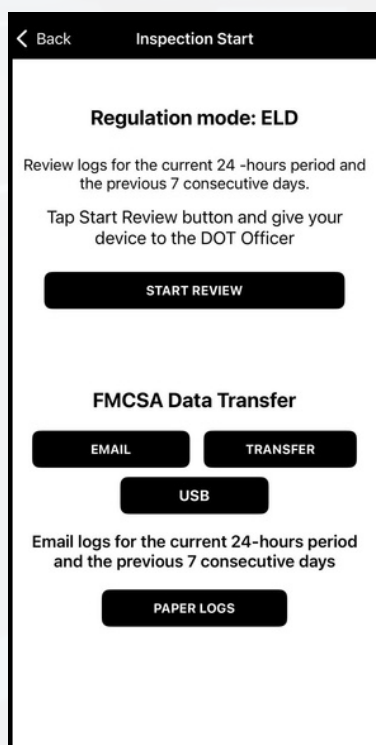


- Click More options in the menu bar.

Roadside Inspection




- Tap the menu icon on the left.



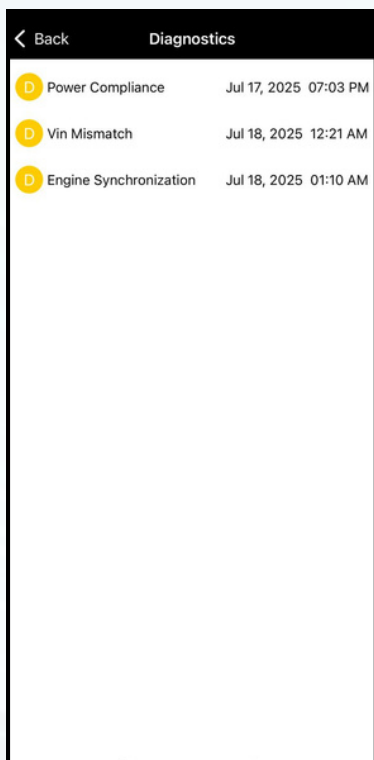
